



Rationale/Purpose

The St John Paul II College Uniform is an important part of our school's identity and community and should be worn with pride and respect. Uniforms assist all students to feel equal with each other and also to relieve the teenage pressure to have the latest clothing and labels. By removing this competition students are able to focus on their learning and other more important social and life skills. Policy regarding footwear and hats relates to Health and Safety requirements.

Junior Uniform – Years 7 to 10



Girls Summer Uniform (Term 1 & 4)

- St John Paul II College summer dress. Dress should be knee length or St John Paul II College logo navy blue shorts with white short sleeve with blue piping
- Black lace-up, traditional leather, polishable shoes only. Black sports shoes or canvas shoes are not appropriate and do not conform with health and safety requirements
- Short white socks (above the ankle). No logos or bands of colour
- St John Paul II College red woollen jumper
- St John Paul II College bucket hat



Girls Winter Uniform (Term 2 & 3)

- St John Paul II College pleated skirt. Skirt should be knee length or JPC logo navy blue pant
- St John Paul II College shirt with blue contrast piping. No black or white long sleeve tee-shirts to be visible underneath the school shirt
- Black or navy opaque, footed stockings above 100 denier (no visible socks to be worn under stockings)
- Black lace-up, traditional leather, polishable shoes. Black sports shoes or canvas shoes are not appropriate and do not conform with health and safety requirements.
- St John Paul II College red v-neck jumper
- St John Paul II College navy soft shell jacket with school logo
 - *Jacket/s are optional, however this is the only coat to be worn*
- Beanies and Scarfs in school colours if desired (only to be worn outside)



Boys Summer Uniform (Term 1 & 4)

- Dark grey St John Paul II College school shorts
- Short sleeve blue St John Paul II College shirt
- Long St John Paul II College socks or Grey above ankle socks (No logos or bands of colour)
- Black lace-up, traditional leather, polishable shoes. Black sports shoes or canvas shoes are not appropriate and do not conform with health and safety requirements
- St John Paul II College red woollen jumper
- St John Paul II College bucket hat

Boys winter Uniform (Term 2 & 3)

- Dark grey St John Paul II College long mélange pants
- Long sleeve classic St John Paul II College shirt. No tee-shirts to be visible underneath the school shirt & shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Junior navy & red tie
- St John Paul II College red v-neck jumper
- Black lace-up traditional polishable leather shoes. Black sports shoes or canvas shoes are not appropriate and do not conform with health and safety requirements.
- St John Paul II College navy soft shell jacket with school logo
 - *Jacket/s is optional, however this is the only coat to be worn*
- Beanies and Scarfs in school colours if desired (only to be worn outside).

Senior Uniform – Years 11 and 12



Girls Uniform

- St John Paul II College Navy V-neck jumper
- St John Paul II College short or long sleeve white shirt with red contrast piping or St John Paul II College logo navy blue short or JPC logo navy blue pant
- St John Paul II College knee-length pleated skirt
- Black lace-up leather school shoes- traditional, polishable
- White Socks (Terms 1 and 4)
- Black or navy opaque, footed stockings above 100 denier (no visible socks to be worn under stockings) (Term 2 & 3)
- Short white socks (above the ankle), No logos or bands of colour (Term 1 & 4)
- College Blazer (compulsory for Terms 2 and 3 and formal occasions)
- St John Paul II College bucket hat (Term 1 and 4)
- Beanies and Scarfs in school colours if desired (only to be worn outside)



Boys Uniform

- St John Paul II College Navy V-neck jumper
- St John Paul II College short sleeve white shirt (Term 1 & 4) or St John Paul II College long sleeve classic St John Paul II College shirt (Term 2 & 3) & shirts must be tucked in at all times. No tee-shirts to be visible underneath the school shirt.
- St John Paul II College tie blue with logo (Term 2 and 3)
- St John Paul II College dark grey shorts (Term 1 & 4) and St John Paul II College dark grey long mélange pants (Term 2 & 3)
- Black lace-up leather school shoes- traditional, polishable
- Grey ankle or the College long socks (above ankle socks) no logos
- College Blazer (compulsory for Term 2 and 3 and formal occasions)
- St John Paul II College bucket hat (Term 1 & 4)
- Beanies and Scarfs in school colours if desired (only to be worn outside).

****Please note that on formal occasions when students are required to wear the red blazer. This will need to be worn with the winter pant, shirt and tie for the male cohort****

Senior jerseys will be available to purchase for year 12 students these cannot be worn at formal occasions and are not compulsory

All Year Levels



PE Uniform

All students are required to change into their PE uniform at the beginning of each PE class and to change back into their normal uniform after PE class unless they have PE during the last lesson of the day. Students participating in other subjects areas eg Technology or The Arts are also required to be changed into full school uniform at the end of the day.

- St John Paul II College PE polo shirt and College shorts or
- St John Paul II College PE Polo shirt, tracksuit pants and tracksuit jacket
- Sports shoes. Converse, volleys, vans and ballet flats are not acceptable at any time and are not safe footwear for sport.
- Students may also wear the St John Paul II College tights
- St John Paul II College hat or plain navy bucket hat
- St John Paul II College PE bag (to carry uniform)



Bag

- **All students are to use the College approved navy-blue backpack (no bags are to be taken to classes).**



Hats

- Hats - either the St John Paul II College official hat or plain blue navy bucket hat-
- Students are strongly encouraged to wear hats during Term 1 and Term 4 as well as make use of sun screen provided at the Front Office.

Navy Soft Shell Jacket

The Navy Soft Shell Jacket with School logo will replace the Winter navy Weather-Proof jacket.

The Weather-Proof jacket is no longer part of the school uniform and should not be worn to and from school.

Jewellery

Jewellery for junior students should be simple and consist of no more than:

- Two studs or sleepers in the lobe of each ear
- A necklace that is discrete, which may reflect the Christian tradition and if not is deemed as inclusive and appropriate to be worn within a school environment. No other items of jewellery to be worn.
- A watch
- No visible face or body piercings or tattoos

Jewellery for senior students should be simple and consist of no more than:

- Two studs or sleepers
- Jewellery that is discrete, which may reflect the Christian tradition and if not is deemed as inclusive and appropriate to be worn within a school environment (exceptions may be when this is deemed to be a hazard in).
- A watch
- No visible face or body piercings or tattoos

Hair

- Hair-styles should be natural looking and age appropriate. This includes no unnatural colours (e.g. Blue, pink bright red). No extreme styles such as shaved patterns or dreadlocks (outside of cultural circumstances).
- Long hair must be tied back in Practical Classes. Hair needs to be off the face and neat and tidy.
- All hair accessories to be only in St John Paul II College colours.

Facial Hair/Beards

- Facial/Beards, if worn, must be short and neatly trimmed.

Nails

- Nails should look natural. No nail polish for Junior school students. Senior students may wear nail polish, if worn, can only be a light neutral colour. No plastic, fake or acrylic nails to worn at school by any student.

Makeup

- Junior students may wear lightly applied, natural coloured foundation and black/brown mascara only.
- Seniors may wear discreetly applied and conservative makeup.

Please note: school colours are Navy Blue, Cardinal Red and White.



Procedures for Uniform Breaches

We ask parents to work with us to ensure that students wear the correct uniform and take pride in the uniform guidelines. Should a student attend school not wearing the appropriate uniform or not wearing it appropriately an entry will be made in our Compass records & parents may be notified. Serious or ongoing uniform breaches may result in the student being sent home to parents/guardians until the situation is rectified. Students may be removed from external school activities or school-based activities if not in the correct uniform. Students who consistently ignore the uniform policy will need to attend a meeting with their parents and St John Paul II College staff to resolve the issue. Uniforms are always to be worn correctly before and after school hours when the students are in public as the students are representing the College when in the community. The College has second hand uniform available for families from the Front Office for students who require.
